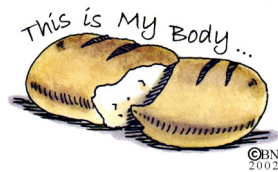

Re-Registration

Re-registration forms were sent home a few weeks ago. If you did not get a re-registration form, please come by the CCD office.

Re-registrations for 2017/2018 are due back by June 30th. We will only recruit the number of teachers we need. These teachers also need to be fingerprinted. It is important that we have our staffing figured out by July 1st. If you do not re-register on time, we cannot guarantee you placement on the night or with the teacher you prefer. Please re-register as soon as possible whether you are prepared to pay the tuition at that time or not. Tuition can be paid in the fall when classes begin if necessary.

We will begin promptly at 5:30. Please allow yourself enough time to get parked and into the Church on time.

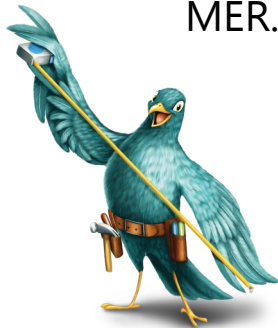
