Know the Mass (in order)

5. The Concluding Rites

### **Know the Ten Commandments**

1. I am the Lord your God; **you shall not have any other Gods before me.**
2. You shall not; **use the name of God in vain.**
3. Remember to keep; **holy the sabbath.**
4. Honor your; **Mother and Father**
5. You shall not; **kill.**
6. You shall not commit; **adultery**
7. You shall not; **steal.**
8. You shall not bear false witness; **against your neighbor.**
9. You shall not covet; **your neighbor's wife.**
10. You shall not covet; **your neighbor's goods.**

### **Know the Greatest Commandment**

- Love God with your whole heart, mind, and soul.
- Love your neighbor as yourself.

Know the Sacraments of Healing are: **Confession and Anointing of the Sick.**

Know the Sacraments of Service are: **Holy Orders and Marriage.**

Know the Sacraments of Initiation are: **Baptism, Communion and Confirmation.**

Know which Sacraments you only receive once: **Baptism, Holy Orders and Confirmation.**

What is the **first** Sacrament you receive? **Baptism.**

What sacrament do you receive **forgiveness**? **Confession**

Know: Advent falls during December and lent begins on Ash Wednesday.

Know that the Eucharist **IS** the True Presence of Jesus body and blood **NOT** unblessed bread and wine.

The Ten Commandments are rules that God gave us to follow.

The Last Supper was with Jesus and his Apostles.

Jesus died on Good Friday.

The Holy family is Mary, Joseph and Jesus.

Know the Apostles Creed. It will be a “fill in the blanks” and there will be a word bank provided.
