Know the **10 Commandments** in Order and what each one means.

- 1. I am the Lord your God, thou shall not have strange Gods before me.
- 2. Thou shall not take the Lord's name in vain.
- 3. Remember to keep Holy the Sabbath Day.
- 4. Honor your Mother and Father.
- 5. Thou shall not kill.
- 6. Thou shall not commit adultery.
- 7. Thou shall not steal.
- 8. Thou shall not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
- 9. Thou shall not covet thy neighbor's wife
- 10. Thou shall not covet thy neighbor's goods.

Know all **7 Sacraments** and their definition.

- 1) **Baptism** – Water cleansing us from original sin and welcomes us into the family
 - 2) **Eucharist** – Receiving the Body and Blood of Christ.
 - 3) **Reconciliation** – Cleansing from sin and receiving absolution (forgiveness) from God.
 - 4) **Confirmation** – Receiving the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit.
 - 5) **Holy Orders** - When a man devotes his life to God and the mission of Jesus Christ.
 - 6) **Marriage** - Commitment of a Man and Woman to join their lives before God.
 - 7) **Anointing of the Sick** - Prayers, blessings and anointing of those who are ill or dying.
- **Sacraments of Initiation**; Baptism, Eucharist & Confirmation.
 - **Sacraments of Healing**; Anointing of the Sick & Reconciliation
 - **Sacraments of Service**; Holy Orders & Marriage

Know the **7 Capital Sins**.

- Pride, Envy, Wrath, Lust, Gluttony, Sloth, Greed

Know the **4 Marks of the Church**

- One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic

Know the **2 Great Commandments** as told by Jesus.

- **Love God** with your whole heart, mind and soul. **Love Others** as yourself.

Know the **Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy** and what they mean.

- **Spiritual** - *help people's spiritual needs.*
 - Instruct the Ignorant, Counsel the Doubtful, Admonish the Sinners, Bear wrongs Patiently, Forgive offenses Willingly, Pray for the Living and the Dead.
- **Corporal** - *acts that help people's physical needs.*
 - Feed the Hungry, Clothe the Naked, Shelter the Homeless, Visit the Sick and Imprisoned, Bury the Dead.

Know the **Cardinal and Theological Virtues** and what they mean.

- **Cardinal**; Prudence, Justice, Fortitude, Temperance
- **Theological**; Faith, Hope and Love

Know the **Holy Trinity**

- God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit

Know the difference between a

Mortal Sin - deadly, grave, or serious sin

Venial Sin - a minor sin, not as serious as mortal.

Know the **Beatitudes**; what they are and that they came from **Jesus**.

- Blessed are the poor in Spirit, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven.
- Blessed are they who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the land.
- Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be satisfied.
- Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.
- Blessed are the clean of heart, for they will see God.
- Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called the children of God.
- Blessed are those who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven.

Know the **Gifts of the Holy Spirit - 7**

- Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear (Awe) of the Lord
