A story from Jesus that teaches a life lesson is a **Parable**.

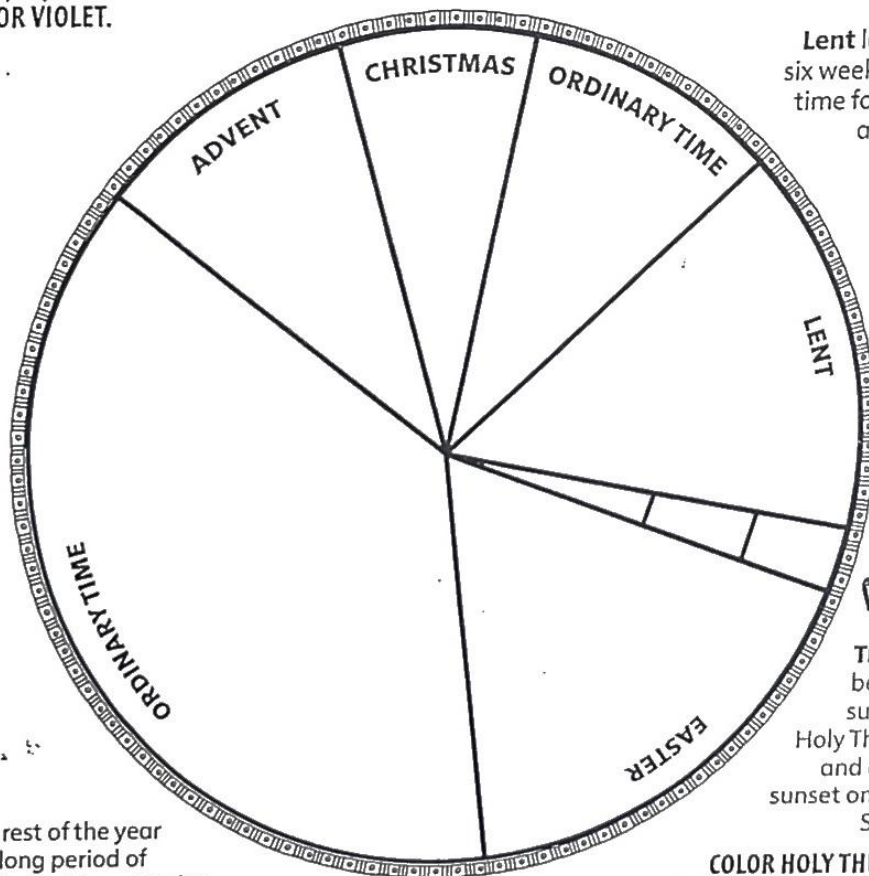
Know the Liturgical Seasons and when they are.

The Church year begins with **Advent**, which lasts about four weeks. It is a time of quiet waiting and preparation
COLOR VIOLET.

The **Christmas** season lasts about three weeks. It is a time for joy. **COLOR WHITE.**

Between Christmas and Lent, there is a short period of **Ordinary Time**.
COLOR GREEN.

Lent lasts about six weeks, and is a time for penance and prayer.
COLOR VIOLET.



The **Triduum** begins at sunset on Holy Thursday and ends at sunset on Easter Sunday.

COLOR HOLY THURSDAY AND EASTER SUNDAY WHITE.
COLOR GOOD FRIDAY RED.

The rest of the year is a long period of **Ordinary Time**. It takes up most of the summer and fall. It is a time to grow closer to God.
COLOR GREEN.

The **Easter** season lasts about seven weeks. It ends on Pentecost. It is a joyful time. **COLOR WHITE.**
